

# Spiritual Practice for Advent Two:

# "Remember Your Baptism"

Mark 1:8 "I have baptized you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit."

The focus of the second week of Advent is our repentance. Baptism reminds us that we need to repent in order to make room for God in our lives.

Meditation Exercise: Throughout this week use your everyday encounters with water as simple, brief reminders of your baptism.

For example, rinsing vegetables, washing your hands, seeing a river or lake, and pouring a glass of water are moments to remember. During these moments, look, listen and feel the water as a way to connect with God. Give God thanks for one of the following aspects of your baptism:

- Forgiveness for your sins
- Renunciation of evil
- Assurance of your identity as God's child
- Dedication to serve in the name of Jesus
- Unity with other believers
