Capital Campaign – Darren CW

2007 – original goal of \$8M – cover immediate maintenance cost, build up building endowment fund, ministry endowment fund – at some point the ministry part was cut out – scaled back to \$6M So far \$4.5M raised - \$2M is from one anonymous donor given as a matching gift, can only count pledges that go into the building endowment fund Immediate building needs - \$1.6M mortgage, \$400k down payment \$614,000 needs to be raised to match the \$2M Intended to start public campaign in 2012 – didn't happen

Postpone until 2013 – year extension on the pledges to Dec 31, 2013

2-2.5 year pledges, but need pledges collected by end of the year

Will lose \$600k if we don't raise it by the end of the year

Launch date – Pentecost Sunday, May 19

Darren is asking all the leaders to make a pledge in advance of May 19

100% participation – any amount – Darren wants to be able to say that the leadership is 100% behind this
