FIRST LESSON

Deuteronomy 10:12-20

So now, O Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you? Only to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all God's ways, to love and serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, and to keep the

commandments of the Lord your God and the divine decrees that I am commanding you today, for your own well-being. Although heaven and the heaven of heavens belong to the Lord your God, the earth with all that is in it, yet the Lord had a heart of love for your ancestors alone and chose you, their descendants after them, out of all the peoples, as it is today. Circumcise, then, the foreskin of your heart, and do not be stubborn any longer.
