FIRST LESSON Leviticus 4:22-26

When a leader sins unintentionally and does what is forbidden in any of the commands of the Lord their God, when they realize their guilt and the sin they committed becomes known, they must bring as an offering a male goat without defect. They are to lay their hands on the goat's head and slaughter it at the place where the burnt offering is slaughtered before the Lord. It is a sin offering. Then the priest shall take some of the blood of the sin offering with his finger and put it on the horns of the altar of burnt offering and pour out the rest of the blood at the base of the altar. He shall burn all the fat on the altar as he burned the fat of the fellowship offering. In this way the priest will make atonement for the leader's sin, and they will be forgiven.
