Acts 17:22-31

So Paul stood up in front of the council and said: 'People of Athens, I see that you are very religious. As I was going through your city and looking at the things you worship, I found an altar with the words, "To an Unknown God." You worship this God that you do not know. So I want to tell: This God made the world and everything in it. This God is the sovereign of heaven and earth, and does not live in temples built by human hands. This God does not need help from anyone. This God gives life, breath, and everything else to all people. From one person God made all nations who live on earth and decided when and where every nation would be.

'God has done all this, so that we will look for and reach out and find God. The Lord is never far from any of us, and is the one who gives us the power to live, to move, and to be who we are. "We are God's children," just as some of your poets have said. Since we are God's children, we must not think that God is like an idol made out of gold or silver or stone. The Lord is unlike anything that humans have thought up and made. In the past, God forgave all this because people did not know what they were doing.
