Worship and the Arts (Kathy H.)

 - Decided to not move on this at this time, watch and gather feedback

Children's Council

- Children's programming is using Sign-up Genius, so people can do one-off help (need vax and background check).
- Motion: Children's Ministry will continue to require masking for Participants and Volunteers, in addition Volunteers will be required to have Vaccinations and Background Checks. (Unanimous approval)

- Not much cross-over between and Youth and Children. Elevation is an exception.
- Angie suggested the Youth Council needs to think about Cross-over events and Sibling Groups.
- Motion: Ministries Council empowers Youth Council to make a Covid Policy in the interim until MC meets again. At such time they will bring it to the Ministries Council for approval. (Unanimous approval)
