FIRST LESSON

Ezekiel 34:11-16, 20-24

<sup>11</sup> "For this is what the Sovereign Lord says: I myself will search and find my sheep. <sup>12</sup> I will be like a shepherd looking for his scattered flock. I will find my sheep and rescue them from all the places where they were scattered on that dark and cloudy day. <sup>13</sup> I will bring them back home to their own land of Israel from among the

peoples and nations. I will feed them on the mountains of Israel and by the rivers and in all the places where people live. <sup>14</sup>Yes, I will give them good pastureland on the high hills of Israel. There they will lie down in pleasant places and feed in the lush pastures of the hills. <sup>15</sup>I myself will tend my sheep and give them a place to lie down in peace, says the Sovereign Lord. <sup>16</sup>I will search for my lost ones who strayed away, and I will bring them safely home again. I will bandage the injured and strengthen the weak. But I will destroy those who are fat and powerful. I will feed them, yes—feed them justice!
