# Spotlight on Food Security Programs

North UMC is situated in a food desert – and we have responded to the needs of our community. We have multiple food collections for the Mid North Food Pantry, and we provide two on-site meal ministries:

Bread & Bowl (serves hot meals on-site and offers each visitor a take-away meal; year-round operation, 3 days / week)

- · Significant increase in demand in 2024
- Average weekly visitors +130% since 2022, +30% since January
- 16,000 meals served
- 7,400 visitors served
- North UMC and community volunteers donate 3,750 hours annually

North Church Farmers Market (provides access to fresh, highquality produce, meat, eggs, and prepared foods; six 'rain or shine' market days, July-September 2024)

- 1,200 visitors
- 24 farmers and community organizations participated
- 4,300 free eggs distributed
- North UMC volunteers donate 300 hours each summer

North UMC hosts 40 West Digital, a tech initiative of the MLK Center

- 100 youth and young adults are in the program, annually
- Provides \$235,000 in pay, equipment, and other benefits

#### **Video & Film Production**

- Offers two paid-apprenticeship sessions, a 10-week program teaching 17-24-year-olds the fundamentals of storytelling, video and film production, and editing
- 60% of apprentices go on to take paid roles in the 19-week residency program, supporting client work
- 50% of residency graduates join the staff

#### **Drone Certification**

- Offers two rigorous 19-week sessions, paid-training for young adults preparing for a drone pilot license
- Once certified, each participants receives a commerciallevel drone valued at \$2,500, opening doors for business opportunities and employment
