FIRST LESSON

Genesis 6:8-19

⁸ But as for Noah, the Lord approved of him. ⁹ These are Noah's descendants. In his generation, Noah was a moral and exemplary man, who walked with God. ¹⁰ Noah had three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

¹¹ In God's sight, the earth had become corrupt and was filled with violence. ¹² God saw that the earth was corrupt, because all creatures behaved corruptly on the earth. ¹³ God said to Noah, "The end has come for all creatures, since they have filled the earth with violence. I am now about to destroy them along with the earth, ¹⁴ so make a wooden ark.
