Objective of the Internship

This position exists for the mutual benefit of North United Methodist Church and the intern. North Church receives an individual who can offer their own set of skills, knowledge, interests, and passions to support and enhance our North Church ministry. In turn, the intern receives the opportunity to learn and practice ministry in a safe and nurturing environment as the intern continues to discern a call to ministry.

Profile of the Intern

- Possessing a sense of call to ministry and desiring a place to follow and process that calling
- Willing to develop mentoring relationship with a variety of youth
- Ability to help lead discussions and group activities as a part of a team of adult ministry partners
- Must pass a background check and adhere to Safe Sanctuary policy

Expectations of the Intern

To be an example of Christian health to our students and church members, involving things like:

- Attending Sunday morning worship consistently.
- Taking opportunities to grow in your faith personally.
- Demonstrating appropriate boundaries in life, relationships, and ministry.
- Living out the gospel, not seeking perfection but embracing transparency and grace.

To grow in maturity as a Christian servant and leader:

- Meeting weekly with Minister of Youth & Young Adults, reflecting on ministry principles and evaluating ministry experiences.
- Engaging in reflection of Christian leadership via readings assigned by the Minister of Youth & Young Adults or readings that are a part of any academic program the intern may be a part of.

To serve as a leader in the Youth Ministry of North Church:

- Assist with plans and leadership of the Sunday evening youth ministry program.
- Attend and assist with the Sunday morning youth Sunday school programs.
- Assist with plans and execution of Youth Ministry special events.
- Take opportunities to contact students through social media, texting, and personal contact.
- Assist with some administrative tasks with Minister of Youth & Young Adults.

Accountability Structure

The Youth Intern is directly accountable to the Minister of Youth & Young Adults who works under the Senior Pastor

Commitment & Compensation

The Youth Ministry Intern is a part time position, during the school year, consisting of 10 hours per week.

- Sunday mornings, 9:30 am – 12:00 pm
- Sunday evenings, 5:00 – 8:00 pm
- Weekly meeting with Minister of Youth & Young Adults, 1 hour, TBD
- Monthly Youth Council meetings, 1.5 hours, TBD
- Special Events, TBD

The position pays \$400/month.
